

The Dokan Northern League is a series of four grassroots competitions throughout the year, with two being held in the North East and two in Yorkshire. The aim of the league is to promote grassroots karate development and provide a stepping stone into larger competitions. The categories are designed round children and novice starters, but also offer high grades opportunities to compete locally.

League Rules

A database is kept of every entry from every club and a point system put into place. A win (gold) is 3 points, a silver two points and bronze one point. These points are awarded to the club and an individual tally will also be kept. We will have a league table that carries on through all four tournaments and at the final comp the most successful club will be crowned Northern League Champion. Entries should be made under individual clubs rather than associations.

In addition to the Club Champion, there will also be a most successful kata trophy and most successful individual trophy for the students that amass the most points in the respective disciplines. These are individual points there will be no personal points for teams.

General

- Entry forms must be signed by the official Club coach only. Entry forms without a signed declaration will not be permitted to take part in the championships.
- Cost of entries: All Individuals £15 per event, Team Kumite & Team Kata cost £24 per team. Paris Kata £16 per team/pair. Check category list for the correct category number.
- The minimum number of competitors per event category and the cancellation of events is at the discretion of the organisers.
- Full amount to be sent with entry form, by 7 April 2024. No entries on the day.
- Only the official coach on duty that day may approach the control table for any queries, competitors all spectators must go via their coach for information.
- Spectator's entry fees are £5 and £3 which you pay at the Spectators entrance where you will receive a wristband. Spectators must not pose has coaches and must not be on the control side of the areas.
- All Students who are competing must be fully insured by their association and must have their licences at hand to be checked on the day if required.
- ENTERING UP in individual EVENTS is not allowed. There is a point system in place.
- KATA competitors will NOT be allowed to enter up. You enter one individual kata event only.
- KUMITE competitors will NOT be allowed to enter up one age group above their own.
- In team kata or team kumite a younger student can join a category above their age. Older competitors cannot make up a category below their age.
- All competitors should be aware that the events are run to rules based on WUKF. Slight amendments by the Organisers and Chief Referee may be necessary for a safe running of the championships.
- Any spectator/competitor or coach infringing the above rules will be asked to leave the sports hall, no
 refund will be given, and the name of the club concerned will be reported to their association Executive.
 Shikkaku may be invoked when a contestant or delegations act in a way which harms the prestige and
 honour of Karate-do. We do try to run events to time but unfortunately all competitions do experience slight
 problems. Your help and attention are needed on all the above points, so everyone may enjoy a safe and
 enjoyable day.
- This competition is hosted by Ichiban Karate, part of Dokan Karate Association based on WUKF rules, our referees and judges will be doing their best to ensure the day is ran in a fair and friendly manner and a bit consideration should be shown towards them. We have some apprentice judges helping out on the tatamis.

Rules of Kata And Kumite

Summary of rules for the tournament that have been created using WUKF guidelines. But do not adhere strictly to them, please be aware there are variations, mostly in kata.

Kumite

SHOBU SANBON and SHOBU NIHON Kumite events WILL be used from WUKF system.

In an effort to explain the scoring system, if time is not an issue & dependant on the event, (IPPON, SANBON or NIHON), then the bout is terminated when the score reaches 1 IPPON, or 3 IPPONS or 2 IPPONS. In all events, the highest maximum individual score that can be given at any one time is IPPON. The lowest score that can be given is a WAZA-ARI., also the table scoring system has been adopted from WUKF, whereby a WAZA-ARI. = 1 point & an IPPON. = 2 points (on the score boards).

All Kumite events will be run with a Referee, flag judges or Mirror Judge & Arbitrator. Arbitrator can assist in the decision-making process.

Competitors will wear a RED belt (AKA) & WHITE or blue belt (SHIRO) to identify themselves during the Kumite events. All competitors 12 and under MUST wear a headguard. All competitors 13 yrs plus MUST wear a gum guard. Shin & Foot protection are mandatory in categories 13 years plus and are recommended in 12 years and under. Hand mitts MUST be worn (and be the same colour as the belt i.e. red or white or blue). Blue can be used in place of White for Kumite equipment, but not the belt. Chest guards for females 13 yrs plus, and groin guards for males 13 years plus are compulsory.

Kata events will run as per the POINTS system. Round 1 will be scored from 5.0 to 7.0 (average 6.0). Round 2 will be scored from 6.0 to 8.0 (average 7.0). Round 3 (final round) will be scored from 7.0 to 9.0 (average 8.0).

Rules regarding number of kata IE 2 kata alternate etc are on the entry forms.

All Kata Events will be 2 Rounds, unless there are too few entries - The top 6 competitors will make it into the 2^{nd} round.

Check the entry form front page for more details. = Heian / pinan kata only etc. Competitors can make mix kata styles.

KATA EVENTS 3RD KYU & ABOVE

ANY KATA / ANY STYLE

3rd KYU & Above – Over 13 No Repeating even in the event of a tie break. Under 13 you can use a three kata rotation.

PAIRS & TEAM KATA -

Any kata can repeat

THERE IS A CAP ON ENTRIES. ONCE THE LIMIT IS REACHED THE COMPETITION WILL BE CLOSED TO FURTHER ENTRIES REGARDLESS OF THE DATE.

PLEASE GET YOUR ENTRIES IN QUICKLY TO AVOID ANY DISAPPOINTMENT.

Categories may be merged or cancelled if there are too few entries. Likewise make sure you add age, grade and height or weight to the entry forms as I sections with too many competitors may also be split.

There will be no sections with more than 32 competitors.
